

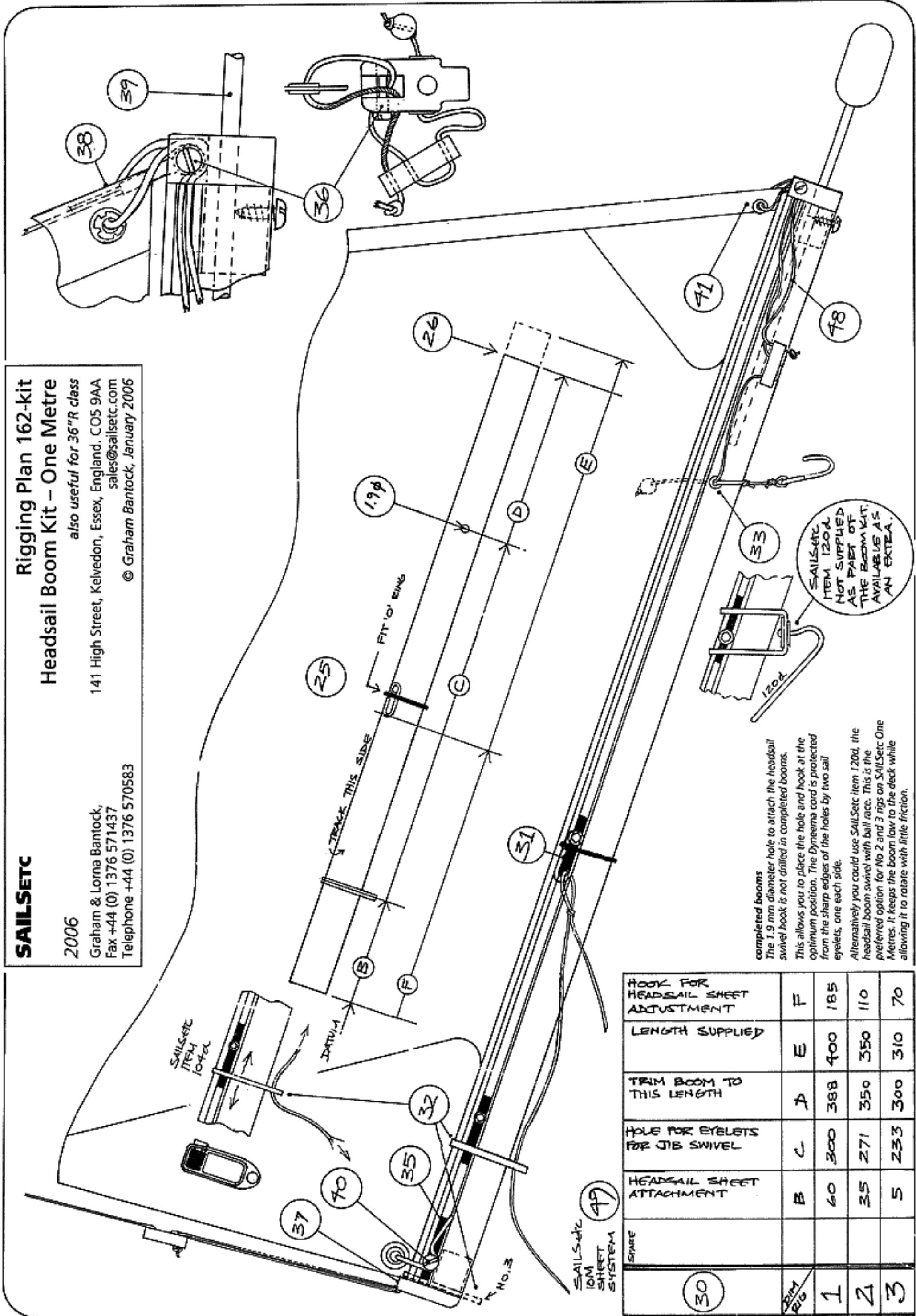

completed booms
 The 1.9 mm diameter hole to attach the headsail swivel hook is not drilled in completed booms.
 This allows you to place the hole and hook at the optimum position. The Dyneema cord is protected from the sharp edges of the holes by two sail eyelets, one each side.
 Alternatively you could use SAILSETC item 120d, the headsail boom swivel with ball race. This is the preferred option for No 2 and 3 rigs on SAILSETC One Metres. It keeps the boom low to the deck while allowing it to rotate with little friction.
